EVENT: 070914-1555

- 5) That LVMPD Detective Bradley Nickell is the investigative and submitting detective on the property related crimes for which Hoyt aka: Monroe is charged. Investigation has revealed Hoyt aka: Monroe is open with his hatred for Detective Nickell as he blames Detective Nickell for his illegal arrest, illegal search warrants and the illegal seizure of "his" property. Hoyt aka: Monroe further believes Detective Nickell is the catalyst behind the sexual related charges. Detective Nickell is currently assigned to the LVMPD Repeat Offenders Program (ROP).
- 6) That Sandra DiGiacomo is a prosecuting attorney with the Clark County Deputy District Attorney's Office (DDA) and is assigned to prosecute Daimon Hoyt aka: Daimon Monroe on the property related charges. DDA DiGiacomo is currently assigned to prosecute ROP cases. Investigation has revealed Hoyt aka: Monroe is open with his expression of hatred for DDA DiGiacomo and openly accuses DDA DiGiacomo of causing him to be illegally arrested and of illegally searching his residence and her personally stealing his property.
- 7) That Michelle Leavitt is a judge in the Eight Judicial District Court in the State of Nevada and presides over District Court 12. Judge Leavitt is the presiding judge over Hoyt aka: Monroe's property related charges. Investigation has revealed Hoyt aka: Monroe is open with his expression of hatred for Judge Leavitt and believes, if convicted, Judge Leavitt will sentence him to spend the rest of his life in prison. During a 09/18/07 covert tape jail recording of Hoyt aka: Monroe, he describes Judge Leavitt as: "Oh Leavitt's a [REDACTED] dude. Leavitt's a [REDACTED]"
- 7) That on or about 08/09/07, affiant received information through a CCDC inmate that Hoyt aka: Monroe was actively soliciting the murders of LVMPD ROP Detective Nickell and DDA DiGiacomo.
- 8) That on or about 09/30/07, affiant received information from Las Vegas FBI S/A S. Bakken that his office received information Hoyt aka: Monroe was actively soliciting the murder of a "Judge Leavitt." The information came to S/A Bakken from a CCDC inmate. S/A Bakken was concerned the Judge Leavitt in question was Federal Magistrate Judge Lawrence Leavitt. It was quickly determined the Judge Leavitt in question was Clark County District Court Judge Michelle Leavitt.
- 9) That beginning on or about 10/01/07 and continuing until 11/12/07, affiant and FBI S/A Bakken conducted a number meetings with the CCDC inmate who continued to cooperate. The CCDC inmate reported meetings with Hoyt aka: Monroe and passed on a number of letters and notes written by Hoyt aka: Monroe. Contained in these letters and notes are clear references to the murder for hire of Judge Leavitt, DDA DiGiacomo and LVMPD Detective Nickell. The price is designated as \$10,000.00 per murder.
- 10) That on 09/18/07, the CCDC inmate agreed to wearing a hidden recorder and to conduct a meeting with Hoyt aka: Monroe during a recreation period. The purpose of this meeting was to document Hoyt aka: Monroe's desire to solicit the murder of Judge Leavitt, DDA DiGiacomo and Detective Nickell. During this meeting Hoyt aka: Monroe confirms he wishes to go forth with the murders and makes mention about having to make contact with his associate "Carlos" to arrange payment.

- 11) That on or about 09/20/07 affiant submitted the letters and notes alleged by the CCDC inmate to have been authored by Hoyt aka: Monroe referring to the murders of Judge Leavitt, DDA DiGiacomo and Detective Nickell to the LVMPD lab for forensic examination.
- 12) That on 10/12/07, LVMPD Forensic Scientist Jan Seaman-Kelly issued a written report confirming the pertinent information contained in the letters and notes mentioned above and related to the murders of Judge Leavitt, DDA DiGiacomo and Detective Nickell were, in fact, written by Daimon Hoyt aka: Daimon Monroe.
- 13) That on 11/15/07, affiant, Sgt. A. Amone and S/A Bakken went to Nevada State Prison (NSP) and interviewed an NSP Inmate. This inmate was housed in the CCDC until his transfer to NSP on 10/23/07. This inmate reported he had been at a number of meetings in September, 2007 between the CCDC inmate and Hoyt aka: Monroe and had personally heard Hoyt aka: Monroe solicit the CCDC inmate to facilitate the murders of Judge Leavitt, DDA DiGiacomo and LVMPD Detective Nickell.
- 14) That based upon the totality of the information above affiant feels probable cause exists to believe the felony crime of Solicitation to Commit Murder (3 cts) has been committed and that Daimon Hoyt aka: Daimon Monroe is the perpetrator thereof.
- 15) That all of the above occurred within Clark County, Nevada.

Wherefore, declarant prays that a Warrant of Arrest be issued for suspect DAIMON HOYT aka: DAIMON MONROE ID#: 715429 on a charge(s) of SOLICITATION TO COMMIT MURDER (3 COUNTS).

I declare under penalty of perjury under the law of the State of Nevada that the foregoing is true and correct.

COUNT 2


